Central in covenant language. God “keeps” His covenant promises, and His people are called to Deuteronomy 7:9Psalm 121:7Deuteronomy 7:11Psalm 127:1Luke 2:19 לָךְ פֶּן תַּעֲלֶה עֲלֵי יָדְךָ בְּכָל מָקוֹם אֲשֶׁר תִּרְאֶה
ESV	Take care that you do not offer your burnt offerings at any place that you see,
NIV	Be careful not to sacrifice your burnt offerings anywhere you please.
NLT	Be careful not to sacrifice your burnt offerings just anywhere you like.
