Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament. From the root קרב, meaning “to come near, approach.” So קרב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalm 103:1
ESV	you shall surely put the inhabitants of that city to the sword, devoting it to destruction, all who are in it and its cattle, with the edge of the sword.
NIV	you must certainly put to the sword all who live in that town. Destroy it completely, both its people and its livestock.
NLT	you must attack that town and completely destroy all its inhabitants, as well as all the livestock.
