

Deuteronomy 15:12

Hebrew	כִּי יִמָּכַר לְךָ אֶחֱיד הָעֶבְרִי אוֹ הָעֶבְרִיָּה וַעֲבַדְךָ שֵׁשׁ שָׁנִים וּבִשְׁנָה הַשְּׁבִיעִית תְּשַׁלַּחְנוּ חֲפָשִׁי מֵעִמְךָ
ESV	“If your brother, a Hebrew man or a Hebrew woman, is sold to you, he shall serve you six years, and in the seventh year you shall let him go free from you.
NIV	If a fellow Hebrew, a man or a woman, sells himself to you and serves you six years, in the seventh year you must let him go free.
NLT	“If a fellow Hebrew sells himself or herself to be your servant and serves you for six years, in the seventh year you must set that servant free.

LXX	ἐάν δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. πράθῃ σοι ὁ ἦ, τό greek Meaning: * The The definite article.
