

Deuteronomy 17:6

ESV	On the evidence of two witnesses or of three witnesses the one who is to die shall be put to death; a person shall not be put to death on the evidence of one witness.
NIV	On the testimony of two or three witnesses a man shall be put to death, but no one shall be put to death on the testimony of only one witness.
NLT	But never put a person to death on the testimony of only one witness. There must always be two or three witnesses.

Sometimes it functions as a indefinitely pronoun ("someone" or "a certain one"). It agrees in gender, number and case with the noun it modifies. Occurs a little under 350 times in the New Testament. KJV	At the mouth of two witnesses, or three witnesses, shall he that is worthy of death be put to death; but at the mouth of one witness he shall not be put to death.

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
