ESV	Like the Anakim they are also counted as Rephaim, but the Moabites call them Emim.
NIV	Like the Anakites, they too were considered Rephaites, but the Moabites called them Emites.
NLT	Both the Emites and the Anakites are also known as the Rephaites, though the Moabites call them Emites.
