

Deuteronomy 20:10

Hebrew	כִּי תִקְרַב אֶל עִיר לְהִלָּחֵם עָלֶיהָ וְקִרְאתָ אֵלֶיהָ לְשָׁלוֹם
ESV	“When you draw near to a city to fight against it, offer terms of peace to it.
NIV	When you march up to attack a city, make its people an offer of peace.
NLT	“As you approach a town to attack it, you must first offer its people terms for peace.

LXX	ἐὰν δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. προσέλθης πρὸς greek Meaning * To or towards * Pertaining to (genitive case) * Near to (dative case) * According to * About Preposition. Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again. At its core, it usually describes movement or relationship toward someone or something, whether physical, s... πόλιν ἐκπολεμῆσαι αὐτήν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐκκαλέσῃ αὐτοὺς greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
