ESV	“If in the land that the LORD your God is giving you to possess someone is found slain, lying in the open country, and it is not known who killed him,
NIV	If a man is found slain, lying in a field in the land the LORD your God is giving you to possess, and it is not known who killed him,
NLT	“When you are in the land the LORD your God is giving you, someone may be found murdered in a field, and you don't know who committed the murder.

	ἐν δέ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. εὐρεθῇ τραυματίας ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigέν greek Preposition meaning “in”. τηῖ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article γῆ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigγῆ Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.
