Hebrew	The Hebrew אֹתְּ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (יְדִיָּהֶם עַל הָעֵגְלָה הָעֲרוּפָה בְּנָחַל
ESV	And all the elders of that city nearest to the slain man shall wash their hands over the heifer whose neck was broken in the valley,
NIV	Then all the elders of the town nearest the body shall wash their hands over the heifer whose neck was broken in the valley,
NLT	“The elders of the town must wash their hands over the young cow whose neck was broken.

	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
