ESV	“If any man takes a wife and goes in to her and then hates her
NIV	If a man takes a wife and, after lying with her, dislikes her

It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. τις λάβη γυναῖκα καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” συνοικήση αὐτῇ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same LXX Personal pronoun (reflexive).
