Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

Meaning

* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ὁ

The definite article βοηθήσων οὐκ ἦν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big εἰμί

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εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. αὐτῇ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big αὐτός

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
