Hebrew	לֹא תִתְעַב אָדָמִי כִּי אֶחָיד הוּא לֹא תִתְעַב מִצְרִי כִּי גֵר הָיִיתָ hebrew The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 בָּאֲרָצוֹ hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אָרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1	
	ESV	Children born to them in the third generation may enter the assembly of the LORD.
	NIV	The third generation of children born to them may enter the assembly of the LORD.
	NLT	The third generation of Edomites and Egyptians may enter the assembly of the LORD.
	LXX	οἱ ἐν γενεῇ τριτῇ αὐτοῖς greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
