| LXX    | <p>οὐκ ἐνεχυράσεις μύλον οὐδέ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* Not * Nor * Neither * Not even</p> <p>A combination of the words οὐ (meaning no) and δέ (meaning however or but). The word οὐδέ adds another negative element to a sentence that already has one. οὐδέ can join words, phrases, or whole clauses.
