ESV	Forty stripes may be given him, but not more, lest, if one should go on to beat him with more stripes than these, your brother be degraded in your sight.
NIV	but he must not give him more than forty lashes. If he is flogged more than that, your brother will be degraded in your eyes.
NLT	But never give more than forty lashes; more than forty lashes would publicly humiliate your neighbor.

It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. προσθῶσιν μαστιγῶσαι αὐτόνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ὕπερ ταύταςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 τάςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article πληγὰς πλείους ἀσχημονήσει ὁplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article ἀδελφός σου ἐναντίον σου
