It is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

Masculine noun. The word is dual in form (ending in יָם-) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14 states that Genesis 1:20Psalm 115:3 בֵד עָבֵיף עֵד הְשָּׁמְדֶף

The LORD will make the rain of your land powder. From heaven dust shall come down on you until you are destroyed.

The LORD will turn the rain of your country into dust and powder; it will come down from the skies until you are destroyed.

The LORD will change the rain that falls on your land into powder, and dust will pour down from the sky until you are destroyed.

Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present.
