This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 בָּהֶן לְאֹת וּלְמוֹפֶת וּבְזָרְעָךָ עַד עוֹלָם
ESV	They shall be a sign and a wonder against you and your offspring forever.
NIV	They will be a sign and a wonder to you and your descendants forever.
NLT	These horrors will serve as a sign and warning among you and your descendants forever.
