Central in covenant language. Hebrew	hebrew The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. ESV	The LORD will establish you as a people holy to himself, as he has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the LORD your God and walk in his ways.
NIV	The LORD will establish you as his holy people, as he promised you on oath, if you keep the commands of the LORD your God and walk in his ways.
NLT	“If you obey the commands of the LORD your God and walk in his ways, the LORD will establish you as his holy people as he swore he would do.

LXX	ἀναστήσαι σε κύριος ὁ greek The definite article θεός greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God σου ἐαυτῷ λαὸν ἅγιον ὃν τρόπον ὥμοσεν τοῖς greek The definite article πατράσιν σου ἐὰν εἰσακούσης τῆς greek The definite article φωνῆς κυρίου τοῦ greek The definite article θεοῦ greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God σου καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” πορευθῆς ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ταῖς greek The definite article ὁδοῖς αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
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KJV	The LORD shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, and walk in his ways.
