	Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament.
	From the root קרב, meaning "to come near, approach." So קרב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalms 103:1 מִיָּנִיחַד מִחֻטֵּב עֲלֵיךָ עַד שֶׁאֵב מִיָּמִיךָ
ESV	"You are standing today all of you before the LORD your God: the heads of your tribes, your elders, and your officers, all the men of Israel,
NIV	All of you are standing today in the presence of the LORD your God-your leaders and chief men, your elders and officials, and all the other men of Israel,
NLT	All of you- tribal leaders, elders, officers, all the men of Israel- are standing today in the presence of the LORD your God.
