	* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 עַּמָּדְּ לָאׁ יַעַזְבֶדָּ לָאׁ תִירָא וְלָאׁ תֵחֶת
ESV	It is the LORD who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed."
NIV	The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged."
NLT	Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the LORD will personally go ahead of you. He will be with you; he will neither fail you nor abandon you."
