	אָרֶץ אָרֶץ hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אָרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 וְהָם רַבְבוֹת אֲפֻלִּים וְהֵם אֲלֶפֶי מִנְשָׁה
