

Deuteronomy 33:20

Hebrew	בָּרַךְ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigבָּרַךְ Meaning * To kneel * To bless God as an act of adoration * To bless man as a benefit * Sometimes, to curse Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament. The word בָּרַךְ marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope. Genesis 1:28 Psalm 103:1 Numbers 6:24 מְרִיב גַּד כְּלָבִיָּא שֹׁכֵן וְטָרֵף זְרוּעַ אֵף קִדְקִד
ESV	And of Gad he said, “Blessed be he who enlarges Gad! Gad crouches like a lion; he tears off arm and scalp.
NIV	About Gad he said: “Blessed is he who enlarges Gad's domain! Gad lives there like a lion, tearing at arm or head.
NLT	Moses said this about the tribe of Gad: “Blessed is the one who enlarges Gad's territory! Gad is poised there like a lion to tear off an arm or a head.
