	Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל
ESV	This is the law that Moses set before the people of Israel.
NIV	This is the law Moses set before the Israelites.
NLT	This is the body of instruction that Moses presented to the Israelites.

	Demonstrative pronoun.
	οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19

The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent).	
It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning παρέθετο Μωυσῆς ἐνώπιον υἱῶν Ἰσραηλ
