The word הָיָה means "to exist" or "to be" or "to become" or "to come into being" and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.

This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.

* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 מָני נְשָׁמֹר 2:2 plugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bigExamples

שמר

Meaning:

* To guard * To protect * To keep * To observe * To attend

The verb שמר occurs about 470 times in the Old Testament.

Central in covenant language. God "keeps" His covenant promises, and His people are called to Deuteronomy 7:9Psalm 121:7Deuteronomy 7:11Psalm 127:1Luke 2:19 אָת פּוֹם yplugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_big.»

Hebrew hebrew

Meaning:

* Face * Presence * Front or surface

Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in ים-), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. יְהוָף plugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bignipautotooltip_bignip-

* Yahweh - God's personal name

lt is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יְהוֹה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

lt an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἡμῖν ἐὰν φυλασσώμεθα ποιεῖνplugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bigποιέω
