	Meaning
	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. NIV	And the LORD was angry enough with Aaron to destroy him, but at that time I prayed for Aaron too.
NLT	The LORD was so angry with Aaron that he wanted to destroy him, too. But I prayed for Aaron, and the LORD spared him.
