	הָיָה קָהָלְתִּי אֲנִי hebrew The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 מֶלֶךְ עַל יִשְׂרָאֵל בִּירוּשָׁלַם
ESV	I the Preacher have been king over Israel in Jerusalem.
NIV	I, the Teacher, was king over Israel in Jerusalem.
NLT	I, the Teacher, was king of Israel, and I lived in Jerusalem.
LXX	ἐγὼ Ἐκκλησιαστῆς ἐγενόμην βασιλεὺς ἐπὶ Ἰσραὴλ ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. Ἰερουσαλημ
KJV	I the Preacher was king over Israel in Jerusalem.

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
