Hebrew	כִּי בָרַב הַכֶּמֶה רַב כְּעַס וְיִוְסִיף יָדַעַת יוֹסִיף מְאֹד
ESV	For in much wisdom is much vexation, and he who increases knowledge increases sorrow.
NIV	For with much wisdom comes much sorrow; the more knowledge, the more grief.
NLT	The greater my wisdom, the greater my grief. To increase knowledge only increases sorrow.
LXX	ὅτι ἐν greek Preposition meaning "in". πλήθει σοφίας πλήθος γνώσεως καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ὅ greek The definite article προστιθεὶς γνώσιν προσθήσει ἄλγημα
KJV	For in much wisdom is much grief: and he that increaseth knowledge increaseth sorrow.

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
