

Ecclesiastes 10:9

Hebrew	מְסִיעַ אֲבָנִים יַעֲצֹב בָּהֶם בּוֹקֵעַ עֵצִים יִסָּכֵר בָּם
ESV	He who quarries stones is hurt by them, and he who splits logs is endangered by them.
NIV	Whoever quarries stones may be injured by them; whoever splits logs may be endangered by them.
NLT	When you work in a quarry, stones might fall and crush you. When you chop wood, there is danger with each stroke of your ax.
LXX	ἐξάιρων λίθους διαπονηθήσεται ἐν αὐτοῖς greek Preposition meaning “in”. αὐτοῖς greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
