	Meaning:
	* Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country
	The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 יֵרֵדוּ מֵאֵם וְאֵם מִן הַשָּׁמַיִם וְיָשְׁבוּ בָאָרֶץ
ESV	If the clouds are full of rain, they empty themselves on the earth, and if a tree falls to the south or to the north, in the place where the tree falls, there it will lie.
NIV	If clouds are full of water, they pour rain upon the earth. Whether a tree falls to the south or to the north, in the place where it falls, there will it lie.
NLT	When clouds are heavy, the rains come down. Whether a tree falls north or south, it stays where it falls.
