	קִמְרַי קִמְרַי Meaning: Hebrew * To guard * To protect * To keep * To observe * To attend The verb קִמְרַי occurs about 470 times in the Old Testament. Central in covenant language. ESV	in the day when the keepers of the house tremble, and the strong men are bent, and the grinders cease because they are few, and those who look through the windows are dimmed,
NIV	when the keepers of the house tremble, and the strong men stoop, when the grinders cease because they are few, and those looking through the windows grow dim;
NLT	Remember him before your legs- the guards of your house- start to tremble; and before your shoulders- the strong men- stoop. Remember him before your teeth- your few remaining servants- stop grinding; and before your eyes- the women looking through the windows- see dimly.
