Hebrew	כִּי מִי יֹאכַל וּמִי יִשְׂתֶּה חוּץ מִמֶּנִּי
ESV	for apart from him who can eat or who can have enjoyment?
NIV	for without him, who can eat or find enjoyment?
NLT	For who can eat or enjoy anything apart from him?
LXX	ὅτι τίς φάγεται καὶ αὐτόν greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" τίς φείσεται πάρεξ αὐτοῦ αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
KJV	For who can eat, or who else can hasten hereunto, more than I?
