Hebrew	* To guard * To protect * To keep * To observe * To attend The verb שמר occurs about 470 times in the Old Testament. Central in covenant language. God “keeps” His covenant promises, and His people are called to Deuteronomy 7:9Psalm 121:7Deuteronomy 7:11Psalm 127:1Luke 2:19 לְבַעְלֵי לָעֵתוֹ
ESV	Sweet is the sleep of a laborer, whether he eats little or much, but the full stomach of the rich will not let him sleep.
NIV	The sleep of a laborer is sweet, whether he eats little or much, but the abundance of a rich man permits him no sleep.
NLT	People who work hard sleep well, whether they eat little or much. But the rich seldom get a good night's sleep.

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἄφρων αὐτόν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
