ESV	For it comes in vanity and goes in darkness, and in darkness its name is covered.
NIV	It comes without meaning, it departs in darkness, and in darkness its name is shrouded.
NLT	His birth would have been meaningless, and he would have ended in darkness. He wouldn't even have had a name,
