ESV	For as the crackling of thorns under a pot, so is the laughter of the fools; this also is vanity.
NIV	Like the crackling of thorns under the pot, so is the laughter of fools. This too is meaningless.
NLT	A fool's laughter is quickly gone, like thorns crackling in a fire. This also is meaningless.

	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” γε τοῦτο

	Meaning:
	* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it
	Demonstrative pronoun.
	οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19
