Verb occurring around 20 times in the Old Testament. It is sometimes used literally, and, at other times, figuratively.

Biblical Examples

Intransitive sense

Used when light itself shines or dawns. Isaiah 60:1 Exodus 13:21 פָּנִי plugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip\_big

hebrew

Meaning:

\* Face \* Presence \* Front or surface

Noun. Masculine.
