ESV	The words of the wise heard in quiet are better than the shouting of a ruler among fools.
NIV	The quiet words of the wise are more to be heeded than the shouts of a ruler of fools.
NLT	Better to hear the quiet words of a wise person than the shouts of a foolish king.

Related to the verb λέγω. λόγος in Greek Thought Before the New Testament, λόγος already had deep philosophical use. In Greek philosophy, λόγος was the rational principle that ordered the universe, the divine reason that structured all things.
