IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἀμαρτάνων εἷς greek Meaning: * One * First * One thing * Alone * Individual * One ma * Someone εἷς is the cardinal number ("one"). Sometimes it functions as a indefinitely pronoun ("someone" or "a certain one"). It agrees in gender, number and case with the noun it modifies. Occurs a little under 350 times in the New Testament.
