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|  | <div>εἰς οἰκονομίαν τοῦ</div> <div>greek</div> <div>The definite article</div> <div>greek</div> <div>The definite article</div> <div>greek</div> <div>The definite article</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning</div> <div>* All * Every * The whole</div> <div>Adjective.</div> <div>Usage in the New Testament</div> <div>The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.</div> <div>With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ἐν</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Preposition meaning "in".</div> <div>greek</div> <div>The definite article</div> <div>Christ means "anointed one"</div> <div>The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ)</div> <div>Noun, masculine.</div> <div>greek</div> <div>The definite article</div> <div>greek</div> <div>The definite article</div> <div>Meaning:</div> <div>* The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens</div> <div>278 occurrences in the New Testament.</div> <div>Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 καὶ</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning</div> <div>* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So</div> <div>Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and"</div> <div>greek</div> <div>The definite article</div> <div>greek</div> <div>The definite article</div> <div>Meaning:</div> <div>* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)</div> <div>Feminine noun. Connected to the English words "ground", "geometry" and "geology".</div> <div>It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 ἐν</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Preposition meaning "in".</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning</div> <div>* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same</div> <div>Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.</div> <div>Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)</div> |
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| ESV | as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.                                                                 |
| NIV | to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment—to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ.             |
| NLT | And this is the plan: At the right time he will bring everything together under the authority of Christ— everything in heaven and on earth.                           |
| KJV | That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him: |
