Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) γάρ ἔσμενplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ποίημα, κτισθέντες ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigγέν greek Preposition meaning “in”. Χριστῷplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigΧριστός Christ means “anointed one” The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ) Noun, masculine. Ἰησοῦ ἐπὶ ἔργοις ἀγαθοῖς οἷςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigός, ἦ, ὅ greek Meaning: * Who * Which * What Greek The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent). It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning προητοίμασεν ὁplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ, ἦ, τό greek Meaning: * The The definite article. 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ESV	For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.
NIV	For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
NLT	For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.
KJV	For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

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
