Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.	
	παρρησιάζωμαι ὡς δεῖ με λαλῆσαι.	
ESV	for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak.	
NIV	for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should.	
NLT	I am in chains now, still preaching this message as God's ambassador. So pray that I will keep on speaking boldly for him, as I should.	
KJV	For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.	

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
