Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) παρρησιάσωμαι ώς δεῖ με λαλῆσαι. **ESV** for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak. NIV for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should. I am in chains now, still preaching this message as God's ambassador. So pray that I will keep NLT on speaking boldly for him, as I should. For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak. KJV

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
