When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 וְאֵי הַיָּם
ESV	King Ahasuerus imposed tax on the land and on the coastlands of the sea.
NIV	King Xerxes imposed tribute throughout the empire, to its distant shores.
NLT	King Xerxes imposed a tribute throughout his empire, even to the distant coastlands.

LXX	ἔγραψεν δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ὁ greek The definite article βασιλεὺς τέλη ἐπὶ τὴν greek The definite article βασιλείαν τῆς greek The definite article τε γῆς Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” τῆς greek The definite article θαλάσσης
