\* Yahweh - God's personal name

It is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יהוֹה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

Hebrew The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
