δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἔσεσθέρlugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigείμί

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. μοι βασίλειον ἱεράτευμα καὶρlugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigκαί

Demonstrative pronoun.
