Hebrew	hebrew The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ.Genesis 1:1 צִפְרָה בְּתוּ לְמֹשֶׁה
ESV	And Moses was content to dwell with the man, and he gave Moses his daughter Zipporah.
NIV	Moses agreed to stay with the man, who gave his daughter Zipporah to Moses in marriage.
NLT	Moses accepted the invitation, and he settled there with him. In time, Reuel gave Moses his daughter Zipporah to be his wife.

It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English.
