ESV	“Whoever strikes a man so that he dies shall be put to death.
NIV	“Anyone who strikes a man and kills him shall surely be put to death.
NLT	“Anyone who assaults and kills another person must be put to death.
LXX	ἐὰν δέ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. πατάξῃ τίς τινα καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀποθάνῃ θανάτῳ θανατούσθω
