Hebrew	The word וַיֵּהָיֵאָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 מִשְׁחָה בָּהֶר אֲרָבָעִים יוֹם וָאַרְבָּעִים לַיְלָה
ESV	Moses entered the cloud and went up on the mountain. And Moses was on the mountain forty days and forty nights.
NIV	Then Moses entered the cloud as he went on up the mountain. And he stayed on the mountain forty days and forty nights.
NLT	Then Moses disappeared into the cloud as he climbed higher up the mountain. He remained on the mountain forty days and forty nights.
