	The Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article מָ, Genesis 1:1 מָלְשָׁת.
ESV	And you shall make horns for it on its four corners; its horns shall be of one piece with it, and you shall overlay it with bronze.
NIV	Make a horn at each of the four corners, so that the horns and the altar are of one piece, and overlay the altar with bronze.
NLT	Make horns for each of its four corners so that the horns and altar are all one piece. Overlay the altar with bronze.
