ESV	You shall set in it four rows of stones. A row of sardius, topaz, and carbuncle shall be the first row;
NIV	Then mount four rows of precious stones on it. In the first row there shall be a ruby, a topaz and a beryl;
NLT	Mount four rows of gemstones on it. The first row will contain a red carnelian, a pale green peridot, and an emerald.

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. σάρδιον τοπάζιον καὶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί

εἷς is the cardinal number (“one”). Sometimes it functions as a indefinitely pronoun (“someone” or “a certain one”). It agrees in gender, number and case with the noun it modifies. Occurs a little under 350 times in the New Testament.Matthew 8:19John 10:30
