The definite article ἔθνη πρὸ προσώπου σου καὶ

Meaning

* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” πλατύνω τὰ

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The definite article ὀριά σου οὐκ ἐπιθυμήσει οὐδεὶς τῆς

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The definite article γῆς

Meaning:

* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)

Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.

It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 σου ἡνίκα ἂν ἀναβαίνης ὁφθῆναι ἐναντίον κυρίου τοῦ

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The definite article θεοῦ

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Masculine noun meaning:

* A god or goddess * God σου τρεῖς καιροὺς τοῦ

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The definite article ἐν αὐτοῦ

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
