Hebrew	אתָּplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The Hebrew אתָּ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרֵא אֱלֹהִים (יִרְתִּיקָ שְׂבָעָה וּמִלְקָחֶיהָ וּמַחֲתִיקָּהּ) טְהוֹרָהplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew Meaning * Clean * Pure Adjective. The word טְהוֹר (from the root טהר) can be used to describe physical, ceremonial or moral purity, depending on the context. It is contrasted with the word טָמֵא which means unclean or impure.
