	The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֵא אֱלֹהֵים (נְחְשֶׁת בָּים) בָּרָא
ESV	He made horns for it on its four corners. Its horns were of one piece with it, and he overlaid it with bronze.
NIV	They made a horn at each of the four corners, so that the horns and the altar were of one piece, and they overlaid the altar with bronze.
NLT	He made horns for each of its four corners so that the horns and altar were all one piece. He overlaid the altar with bronze.
